Dr. Ramchandra Kashinath Shirodkar who was founder of the school was born in the year 1890 in the village Shiroda. Dr. Shirodkar wanted to pursue higher studies & was looking for ways and means for obtaining scholarship. He secured Dhamankar scholarship and went to Baroda for higher studies. Wangler Paranjape took him under his wing and joined in Pune's Fergussion College. Then there he completed inter science and came to Mumbai and joined Elphinstone College & passed B. Sc. securing First Class. In 1930, Jat Sansthan Maharaja sent him England & there he received Ph.D. degree. He returned Mumbai and started working in Social service League in Parel.

During that time Mumbai was reeling under epidemic of incluensa. Dr. Shirodkar provided the medicines to the affected people. He observed their poor living conditions and illiteracy. He wanted to bring about social awareness among the people and wanted to educate their children. He worked as Principal in Shri. Shivaji High School in Pune. He was a social reformer, educationalist, Journalist & Scholar. He had a great vision and became a social role model for the general public & has carved a place in many hearts. Dr. Shirodkar spent all his life in Educating, Imparting knowledge for the upliftment of the poor worker. He swept aside all the hardships, pain and sorrow in his personal life to educate the poor. He loved this Institute & would lovingly look after the needs of the students, teachers & his fellow member of the community. The Motto of this institutes is ''योग:कर्मसु क्रीशर्ल्म्'' has evolved from the work & life of Dr. Shirodkar Sir. He did not live long, but his keenness to work for the upliftment of his fraternity continue to inspire the society to become prosperous & enlightened.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

1) School Timings And Attendance Of Students:

- 1) Upper Primary section will work-from-7.20 am to 12:20 p.m. Primary & Secondary Section will work from 7:10 am to 1.15 pm AISSE
- 2) The School May have to change timings on certain occasions such as unit tests, semester examination, S.S.C. examination etc and shall intimate the students well in advance.
- 3) The Students should regularly attend the school as well as the extra classes conducted by teachers.
- 4) The students should be present into their respective classes at least ten minutes before the prayer begins and immediately after the recess is over. Late arrivals in these cases are liable for action.
- 5) The Students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises during school hours. No permission shall be granted, except for genuine reasons, arising out of emergency, to go home. In such cases either of the parent or the guardian should collect their ward from the school.
- 6) 75% attendance per term is compulsory for each student and in the absence of which the student shall be prohibited from attending the final examination.
- 7) If a students is not fulfilling the criteria of attendance, as mentioned above, on account of medical reasons, then it will be considered up to the limit of 60%. In such cases, medical certificates from registered practitioners, stating the nature of the sickness and subsequent period of absence that is required to recover should be submitted in school.
- 8) If a student is representing the school at district, state or national level in sport competitions conducted by sports Authority of India or any other organization which is recognized by Government of Maharashtra.
- 9) After given vacations students should attend the opening day of the the School Camplusary otherwise fine will be charge

THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

- The pattern & material of the entire uniform is prescribed by the school.
- The school uniform must always be clean & the students must look smart.(Special attention should be paid to personal hygiene.)
- During winter season dark marroon colour sweater is allowed. Black leather shoes (With buckles for girls & laces for boys & white socks) should be worn by the students.
- During rainy season black rainy shoes will be allowed.
- On school days, open house, functions, picnics & excursions pupils should wear school uniforms with Identity Card.
- On P. T. days students should wear P. T. uniform with white canvas shoes & white socks, white ribbon/clip/hair bands must be used by girls to keep their hair neat & tidy. Boys should have their hair cut one inch above their ears. No fashionable hair cut is permitted.



LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- Once a student attends the school, he/she will not be allowed any sort of leave. In case of emergency the child be escorted home by the parent/quardian with the permission of the Principal.
- If a pupil is absent due to illness or any other reasons the Parents must be informed to Principal at once & the pupil returning to school must state the reason for absence on the relevant leave Record page in school calendar. In the case of illness a medical certificate & test papers are essential.
- A pupil who is absent for a month without previously informing the Principal & obtaining the prior permission will have his / her name struck off the school register.
- 5. Absence for more than 7 days from the opening day of school tenders a pupil liable to be struck off the roll.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

- 1) Good manners, courtesy & politeness is the hall mark of good students.
- 2) Use of vulgar & objectionable, display of violent behavior etc., will not be allowed.
- 3) Students must show due consideration to all members of society. His/her speech should not hurt or offend anyone.
- 4) Misuse of school property/scribbling on wall, furniture, bulletin boards etc. will be severely dealt with. Breakage of any kind are liable for a fine & or payment for replacement/repairs.
- 5) The School premises must be kept neat & clean. Litter of any kind must be thrown in dustbins/waste paper baskets.
- 6) Students are not allowed to carry mobile phones to school, excursions, picnics etc. The same if found will be confiscated by the school authorities.
- 7) Girls will not be allowed to use mehendi, nail polish, perfume, unsuitable dresses or fancy wrist watches & modern hairstyle & long nails. Jewellery is strictly prohibited.
- 8) Soft drink plastic bottle will not be used as water bottles.
- 9) Irregular attendance, Habitual idleness, disobedience or conduct causing physical injury to fellow members will be considered sufficient reason for dismissal of pupil at the discretion of the school authorities.
- 10) Books or periodicals or other materials should not be brought unless approved by Principal.
- 11) Collection of money for any purpose shall not be allowed without the prior sanction of Principal.
- 12) No pupil is permitted to leave the school premises during working hours inclusive of recess without the written permission of the Principal.
- 13) If a pupil is caught using unfair means in any examination, he/she will not be allowed to appear in the remaining subjects under any circumstances.
- 14) School authorities will not be responsible for loss of personal property of the students. compulsory.
- 15) Participation in co-curricular/extra-curricular activities/ games & sport is compulsory.

LIBRARY RULES

- 1) Perfect silence & order must be maintained in the library.
- 2) Only one book at a time will be issued on appointed days.
- 3) No child may keep the book with him/her for more than 7 days.
- 4) Damage or loss of book will have to be made good or as decided by the authorities.
- 5) Students will not be permitted to appear for their test/examination unless the library book has been returned in good condition & an fine due has been paid.
- 6) Before the book is returned to the library, the necessary entry must be made it school diary on the page reserved for the same.



RULES FOR ADMISSION

- 1) New admissions will be made subject to the vacancies. No correspondence will be entertained .
- 2) Management has the right to admit or refuse admissions to the pupils in the school.
- 3) A candidate who joins fresh from home or from other school has to produce an official Birth certificate such as from Municipal Corporations.

RULES FOR WITHDRAWALS & ISSUE OF SCHOOL LEAVING CERTIFICATE

- Application for the School Leaving Certificate should be made by the parents in the prescribed form available in the school diary. It should state the reason for the student leaving the school & the proposed date of leaving.
- An application for withdrawal in the first term is to be given one calendar month in advance on the prescribed School leaving certificate form. Otherwise fees will be charged.
- School leaving certificate will not be issued until all dues are settled, including returning of Library books & other school property.
- Those who wish to discontinue their children for the next academic year, should apply for the School Leaving Certificate on before 30th of March.



PROGRESS REPORT

- 1) The results of the examination will be entered in the progress report every times of an examination or test is held.
- 2) Progress card will be Shown in II and IV assessment.
- 3) The Progress Report should be promptly returned to ensure proper utilization of the same.
- 4) Parents are earnestly requested to:
 - a) Go through the report carefully and affix their signature Wherever required in token of their pursual.
 - b) Sign against the notified place.

GUIDELINES TO THE PARENTS

- Parents should read the rules given in the diary & check the diary regularly.
- Parents should leave their ward at the school gate.
- On birthdays other than biscuit or chocolates no other items must be distributed in the class.
- Listen to your child first, before moralizing him/her.
- Inculcate discipline, good manners, good habits, orderliness & neatness in person & dress.
- Ensure that your ward is punctual & regular.
- In the interest of your child's safety remember to send leave note for the absence from you in time.
- Please do not send your child to school if he/she is suffering from a contagious disease. During test & Examination no leave will be granted except on medical grounds & medical certificate from the authorized medical officer has to be submitted along with leave application.
- Promptly inform the class teacher about any change in address, phone numbe etc.
- Be regular on Open House & Meetings.
- Make it a point to spend some time everyday with your child in order to know about his/her day, today activities.
- Encourage self-help at work & study so that your child can become independent resourceful.
- All communication regarding fees, admissions, withdrawals, complaint and inquiries regarding the progress of the child should be made to the Principal not to the other members of the staff.
- The decision of the Principal is final in case of promotion. Parents should not wander in the school premises. They are not allowed to go to the classroom
- Parents should send full lunch box like chapattis, rice, vegetable, salad Discourage your child from eating junk food.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ADMISSION & WITHDRAWALS

What is the process for withdrawal of students?

- 1) Parent's Guardians need to submit a application which is printed in the calendar for a school Leaving Certificate. A minimum TWO month notice is required for same.
- 2) The School leaving Certificate will be issued only after all dues are cleared and library books returned.
- 3) School Leaving Certificate may not be issued for the Following reasons:
 - I. Nonpayment of fees and/or other dues.
 - II. Rustication by the Director of Education, State Directorate of Education under Rule 34, School Leaving Certificate will not be issued until the expiry of the period for department form admission to a recognized school.

What are the guidelines for obtaining a Duplicate of the School Leaving Certificate?

- 1) In case a duplicate certificate is required, parents/Guardians will need to submit a written application starting the reason for the request and mention the status of the original certificate.
- 2) Parents / Guardians are required to make an affidavit before a stipendiary Magistrate.
- 3) A certified copy will be issued by the school Principal in two month.

What is the admission Procedure?

You need to visit the school and meet the School Clerk who will then brief you for the entire procedure.

What is the Procedure for getting Bonafide Certificate?

Fill the details printed in the calender Executive at least a week before you need to same.

BIRTHDAYS

How are Birthday's celebrated in school?

- Students may wear casual/Party clothes to school on their birthday.
- Parents will not be allowed to attend birthday celebrations in class
- Only CREAMLESS and EGGLESS cakes are allowed in school.
- Kindly do NOT send any gifts or return gifts with your child.

Can children wear coloured clothes on their birthday?

PENALTY

What is the penalty if my child does not return the Library book on time?

A Late fee of Rs. 10/- per week will be charged after two weeks are over. For Std. The Parents will be asked to replace a lost library book once a period of 4 weeks has elapsed, or reimburse the school for the same.

UNIFORMS

When should the child wear PE Uniform?

The PE Uniform must be worn on PE days only and on days specified by the school authority.

SCHOOL COUNSELOR

What kind of counseling support is given to students? What kind of counseling is given to students?

There is counselor in the school to cater to the needs of students and parents. The counselor not only conducts workshops for students as per the developmentally appropriate topics but also does one are to one counseling with students. The counselor helps in identifying students who might have learning difficulties through observation and informal assessment.

As per the schedule of the counselor from the school, take an appointment with the FOE (front office) of the school to meet the school counselor.

FIRST AID

What kind of medical assistance is given in school?
